Section IV Brown Recruitment Fellowship Application

The Ray E. Brown Fellowship aims to identify and support exceptional students who are committed to the healthcare field and wish to pursue the Graduate Program in Health Administration and Policy while at the University of Chicago. In addition to attracting talented students to the program, the Brown Fellowship provides the opportunity for students to develop leadership skills and fosters interdisciplinary experiences through projects and activities associated with the fellowship.

One incoming student from each of the participating GPHAP schools (the Chicago Booth School of Business, the Harris School of Public Policy and the School of Social, Service Administration) will be selected to receive a \$5,000 fellowship to be distributed over two years.

Brown Fellows are expected to complete the requirements of GPHAP as well as participate in the following leadership activities:

Act as GPHAP student representative during the first year of enrollment including: representing the program to incoming students, and at alumni and at recruitment events.

Work with other Brown Fellows to plan and coordinate an annual GPHAP event that advances the understanding of health care issues on campus and promotes the interdisciplinary aspects of the program.

To apply, students must submit a completed GPHAP application by July 15, 2009. In addition to the GPHAP application, Brown Fellows must provide the following information:

A copy of student's undergraduate and/or graduate transcripts (unless attached to GPHAP application).

A one page letter of recommendation from a former supervisor or colleague in a health related position.

A personal statement regarding student's leadership qualities and experience (can be incorporated into the GPHAP application).

Applications will be reviewed by the GPHAP Faculty Committee and GPHAP Director, and evaluated according to the following criteria:

Commitment and passion to the healthcare field

Good academic standing.

Understanding of the value of interdisciplinary and collaborative approaches.

Ability and willingness to take a student leadership role in the program.
